The only essential to follow in the pandemic is to stay safe and learn about the precautions and need to take the vaccination. This is a very fruitful manner during the current time.






TESTIMONIALS

I had the privilege to work in Street Cause CBIT division for 4 years. (2011-15), in the last year I got to lead the division as the President.



STREET CAUSE THIS YEAR

Slum Adoption Project

The Covid-19 pandemic has created a challenging situation for everyone. Regularly, people are running out of essentials or are undergoing psycho-social stress due to everyday struggles. Post our survey, we identified that the slums in Hyderabad are struggling with no or minimal access to essential necessities in this situation We, at Street Cause, have taken the initiative to help them by distributing monthly groceries to the slums in Hyderabad for three consecutive months

Mask distribution drive

To stop the spread of disease, we require two things, first is limiting the contact with infected individuals via physical distancing and secondly, by reducing the transmission of the virus by wearing a mask. Thus we have taken an initiative to distribute face masks as utility of a mask during the pandemic seems very helpful.

Flood Relief project

The incessant rains in Hyderabad have made lives miserable in the city, especially for people living in the low-lying areas. People are already going through a tough time with the pandemic. The flood has thrown their lives out of balance and has wreaked chaos in their homes. In order to help we provided with basic fundamental necessities.

Hijra Community Project

Due to the current critical pandemic situation it is difficult for them to go out and highly risky. Because of this situation they are not able to get any income through which they have food ration problem. That is why we at Street Cause have come up with an initiative to help them by distributing the dry ration. We have distributed in to the people from the community living in 10 areas

Queer Project

Due to the covid pandemic situation, it is difficult and risky for the people from the community to go out. To help in this situation we distr-ibuted dry ration to the 1100 people from the community.

Immunization Project:

Donation of immunity-boosting kits & Covid precaution instruments to 40 orphanages. To help them in this covid situation as it difficult for them to access the requirements deeming the critical situation

Digital Classroom Project

In this Covid situation, Education has become online based and orphans do not have access to online classes. So, we have come forward to do donations event at orphanages by building them basic computers which are helpful for online classes and basic need.

Food distribution drive

The recent floods are the most devastating floods Hyd has ever faced. Some people lost their shelter & daily bread. In this needful situation, we as take up a Food Distribution project. We distributed cooked food in the affected areas. These one-day meals were provided to the poor and daily wager families were struggling to make their ends meet.

Considering the present critical pan demic situation, we at Street Cause have come up with Project Aasha A platform to help the needy in this COVID situation


